A fabulous place to visit.... ideal for a half term treat.

The Storybarn Liverpool's first interactive story centre for children, The Storybarn, opens next month.

The new project in Calderstones Park boasts a robot and a hot air balloon that children can sit inside for story telling sessions, as well as a two-storey magical tree and even a 'story slide' that can be used to leave the converted Grade 2 listed barn

There's also a magical Shakespeare-inspired outdoor area.

Children up to the age of 12 are invited to read, play and listen to stories inside the The Storybarn for a recommended time of two hours.

The opening of The Storybarn coincides with a new interactive exhibition running until April, also in Calderstones Park.

The exhibition, called "Once There was... The Wonderful World of Oliver Jeffers", focuses on popular children's authors and is designed for three- to six-year-olds.

Parents can buy special tickets that will allow kids to enter the both the Jeffers exhibition and The Storybarn for £9 per child - including one free adult.

Entry to just The Storybarn will cost £5 per child, with group rates available.
