

How you can help at home:

Counting objects around you, the stairs as you climb them. Helping your child to hold a pencil correctly and trace, copy or write their own first name. Talk to them about sharing with other children and play games where you have to take turns. Share some of your favourite stories and songs together.

They will be given opportunities to listen to and use prepositions (words which tell us where something is, 'on' 'under' etc) We will be listening to/acting out and retelling (using toys and costumes) a range of stories.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>R.E.</u></p> <p>In our 'Come and See' lessons the children will be exploring family life through three main themes:</p> <p>Celebrating: To know that we celebrate in different ways and know how the Parish family celebrates.</p> <p>Gathering: To know that families gather together and the Parish gathers together at Mass.</p> <p>Growing: To know that things grow in Spring and that during LENT we are trying to be more like Jesus.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Personal, social and Emotional Development</u></p> <p>Children will be supported as their confidence and self esteem develops. They will be encouraged to understand rules, learning to share and take turns with other children, knowing that their actions can affect others around them. They will also be encouraged to express their feelings and be able to ask an adult for support. We hope to build the children's independence in selecting resources and carrying out self chosen tasks. The children will also be encouraged to learn to be pleased with and be proud of their achievements in Nursery.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>We help the children to take responsibility for their own self care, putting on their coats and washing their hands.</p> <p>We are also talking about how to use equipment safely around the Nursery setting.
