Every child should have new PJ's for Christmas Eve...and we need your help to make sure they do!!

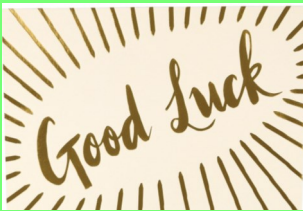
This year, St Columba's will become a drop off point for anybody who would like to donate PJ's or dressing gowns.
