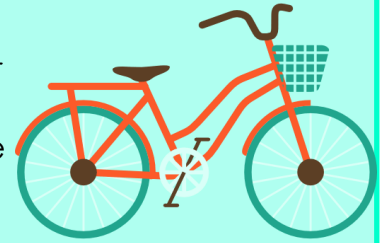
Winners
