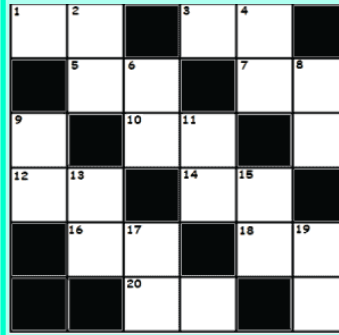
## Winners
