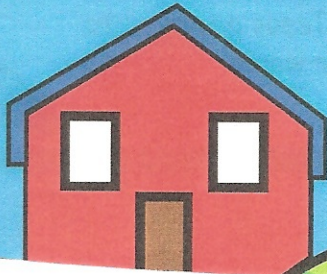
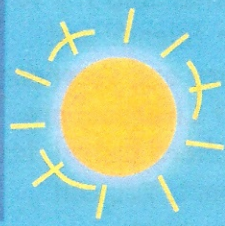


Good Shepherd Newsletter Lent 2015
