Commas

Commas separate words in a list. These might be adjectives or a list of objects.

The old, bearded wizard.

I packed my books, pencil case and lunchbox.



Expected Punctuation

स्थिड्यूड

Full stops mark the end of a sentence.

I like shopping. It is over there.



Question marks

Question marks mark the end of a question.

Where is it? What's the time?



Apostrophes

Apostrophes are used for omission (missing out letters) or possession (showing belonging).

Would not

wouldn't

The pencil belongs to Molly. It is Molly s pencil.



Exclamation marks

Exclamation marks mark the end of an exclamation.

> Ouch! That hurts! What big teeth you have!



Inverced commas

Inverted commas are used to punctuate direct speech.

"How lovely to see you!" exclaimed Mum.
