




How you can help at home?

By completing any homework sheets and spending time reading stories to your child, to encourage their love of reading and writing. <p>English:</p> <p>This term we will be sharing stories with familiar settings eg: The Naughty Bus and The Train Ride. In Poetry we will be learning poems about the senses.</p> <p>As part of our Non-Fiction texts we will be making lists, reading and writing simple captions.</p>	<p>R.E:</p> <p>In RE we are looking at topics children can relate to and discuss with you.</p> <p>Families Belonging Judaism Waiting</p>	<p>Science:</p> <p>Within the topic 'Animals, including humans' the children study different body parts in humans and animals and learn how to conduct and experiment</p> <p>They also study the seasons: Autumn and Winter.</p>
<p>Mathematics:</p> <p>In Year 1 we start a new Maths programme called Singapore Maths, where we combine a lot of practical work and problem solving to extend and challenge the children's understanding of: number and place value, addition and subtraction and shape, space and measure.</p>	<p>Autumn Term 2019</p> <p>Year 1</p> 	<p>Computing:</p> <p>In Year 1 children are taught simple programming skills, shown what algorithms are and see how they are implemented as programs on digital devices. They are also asked to create simple programs.</p>
<p>Art and Design:</p> <p>Children learn simple drawing skills, taking their pencil for a walk, experimenting with doodles and brush strokes to create their own artwork.</p>		<p>D.T:</p> <p>Children make their own Christmas cards and learn how to make a moving picture using pivots and levers.</p>
<p>P.E:</p> <p>In Gymnastics children will be learning different body skills. In Games children will be learning ball skills.</p>		<p>MFL-FRENCH:</p> <p>We learn how to say 'Hello' and 'Goodbye'</p>
<p>History:</p> <p>In learning about how transport has changed over time children will be looking at the history of the bikes.</p>	<p>Trips and Visits:</p> <p>Trip to Church for a Baptism - links with Come and See work on 'Belonging'. Local Area study/walk.</p>	<p>Geography:</p> <p>Children will be exploring their local environment including the school and Local Area.</p>
<p>Personal Development:</p> <p>S.E.A.L (On going): Say No to Bullying Relationships and Sex Education/ Healthy Relationships (On going): To know and understand that relationships are important.</p> <p>No Outsiders in our class - (On going): Being the same/different.</p>
