



Assessment Guide for R.E at St Columba

Teacher Assessment: Each term, teachers assess pupils based on their written work, oral contribution and their participation during worship (Celebration of the Word). Judgements are made in these areas to ensure a well-balanced understanding of religion.

Summative Assessment: This takes place once a term. Judgements are made through moderation in mixed year groups e.g. Y5 and Y6 will moderate together, then by our HT and SLT to ensure consistency. We also moderate with our cluster group.

Insight Tracking: Judgements for pupils are tracked on insight every term (our data tracking system), in line with our other core subjects.
